# Israeli Money

The local Israeli currency is the **New Israeli Shekel** (NIS). Each shekel is worth about 25 cents. NIS coins come in units of: 1 ( $\sim$  25 cents), 2 ( $\sim$  50 cents), 5 ( $\sim$  \$1.25), 10 ( $\sim$  \$2.50)

## NIS Coins





1NIS ~ \$.25

2NIS ~ \$.50



<u>5</u>NIS ~ \$1.25



<u>10</u>NIS ~ \$2.50

#### NOTE:

NIS coins in Israel have much higher value than what you are used to in North America, so watch your shekel coins carefully.

### **EXAMPLES:**

- If you have five 2NIS coins, you have \$2.50
- If you have three 10NIS coins, you have \$7.50.



Israeli coins also come in much smaller denominations (similar to pennies), called agorot. **Agorot coins** come in units of: 5, 10, and 50(½).


### Agorot Coins













two 50 agorot coins = 1 shekel

**Shekel bills** come in units of: 20 (~ \$5), 50 (~ \$12.50), 100 (~ \$25), 200 (~ \$50).
